## 2023 SCHOLARSHIP NOTICE – REVISION 0

Seattle, WA – The Seattle Section of AACE International (Association for the Advancement of Cost Engineering) the Authority for Total Cost Management, announces the opening of the 2023 Scholarship Award Program for undergraduate and graduate students.

### Three (3) Scholarship Awards will be given at \$1,000 each.

- ✓ A membership to the AACEI Seattle Section will also be awarded with each scholarship

**Applications due 11:59 PM on June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2023.**

#### Scholarship Eligibility:

1. **Residency** – Applicants must be Washington State residents at the time of application. Proof of residency can be a Washington State driver's license, or current voter registration, or utility bills for the past two billing periods.
2. **Eligible Academic Programs** – Undergraduate or Post Graduate academic programs that qualify for the Seattle Section AACE International Scholarship Program.
  - ✓ Accounting
  - ✓ Architecture
  - ✓ Building Construction or Environment
  - ✓ Business
  - ✓ Construction Management
  - ✓ Engineering
  - ✓ Other relevant programs (subject to Seattle Section AACE International Board approval)
3. **Eligible Colleges** – Colleges or Universities in the State of Washington with Eligible Academic Programs.
4. **Matriculation Status** - Students who have declared a major in one of the above eligible programs, and subject to acceptance into that program for 2023.
5. **Academics** - Student must have been accepted to an eligible program and have attained at least a 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale with transcript.
6. **Recommendation** – The student must provide one letter of recommendation from their academic program or other non-related professional attesting to the applicant's character.
7. **Essay** – 500-word or less essay that describes the applicant's academic and future professional goals.

**Criteria for Evaluation:**

- GPA - 100 points
- Recommendation - 100 points
- Career Goals - 100 points

8. **Payment of Award** – The scholarship recipient will receive the award in a form of check issued to the person’s name on the application to be used toward the student’s tuition and/or related expenses

- Print and fill out the Application Cover Sheet.
- Convert and compile the Application Cover Sheet and all required documentations in one PDF file, in the following order:
  - 1) Application Cover Sheet
  - 2) Proof of Washington State Residence
  - 3) Proof of enrollment in the eligible program
  - 4) Transcript
  - 5) Letter of Recommendation
  - 6) Essay
